Health & Safety at Work Awareness for Supervisors - 5 Step

Whether you are newly hired or someone who has been working for sometime, this workshop will bring you up to date with the legal requirements and concepts related to the Act.

An employer must ensure that a supervisor who performs work for the employer completes a basic occupational health and safety awareness training program that meets the requirements set out in subsection (3) within one week of performing work as a supervisor.

This training meets the seven learning objective identified in Occupational Health and Safety Awareness Training Regulation 297 Section 2 (3).

On completion you will:

- Understand the duties and rights of all workers under the Occupational Health and Safety Act,
- Understand the duties of the employer and all supervisors under the Occupational Health and Safety Act,
- Understand the roles of the Health & Safety representative and Joint Health & Safety Committees under the Occupational Health and Safety Act,
- Understand the roles of the Ministry, the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board and entities designated under section 22.5 of the Act with respect to occupational health and safety.
- Be able to recognize, assess and control workplace hazards and evaluate those controls.
- Know where you can access additional resources, both internally and external, and that help is always available if you need it.
