Self Contained Breathing Apparatus Hazard Training

The use of SCBA is necessary when the environment has an atmospheric condition that is immediately dangerous to life and health (IDLH) which may result in immediate injury or death. All respiratory equipment users should be trained in the care, use, limitations, and fitting of the respiratory equipment as part of an adequate respiratory protection program.

In order to select the proper equipment for a particular job, it is necessary to know and understand

- the characteristics of the contaminant(s)
- the anticipated exposure conditions
- the performance limitations of the equipment
- any legislation that applies

The employer must determine the degree of danger the conditions that are or may be present at the work site present to the worker. These findings are used to select the respiratory protective equipment appropriate for those conditions.

This 1/2 day Training Program consists of classroom training session, participant evaluation and by a practical evaluation of cylinder replacement, donning and doffing of the SCBA.

This program will provide the participant with the necessary knowledge and skills to:

- Know the legislation specific to SCBA's
- Identify hazards that may require the use of SCBA's
- Evaluate and understand personal limitations
- Identify system components and their functions
- Perform procedures for inspection and maintenance of SCBA system components
- Conduct a pre-use inspection
- Properly don SCBA's and check for fit
