JHSC Part 2 Certification Training

This approved two-day Part 2 Certification course was developed by **Dwight Barratt Consulting Inc.** and addresses the curriculum requirements for certified members of JHSC.

JHSC Part 2 workplace Specific training, the employer is required to select a training program that provides training in a minimum of 6 hazards that are relevant to the committee member's workplace. Training is based on the application of Recognize, Assess, Control and Evaluate (RACE) methodology.

Part 2 Workplace Specific Course Duration: 2 days or 13 hours and must be completed within 12 months of Part 1 training or obtain a one-time extension due to extenuating circumstances.

After successful completion of the required Part 2 training modules, the training provider will notify the MLITSD that the participant has successfully completed the training to become a Certified Member of the JHSC.

Certified members trained under the new Standards will be required to take Refresher training every three years to maintain certification status, or may obtain a one-time exemption for an active JHSC member.

A reminder email through the MLITSD CMS will be sent when a learner has six-months left to complete refresher training to maintain certification status.

Health and Safety Representatives, Health and Safety Coordinators, supervisors and managers could also benefit from this training
