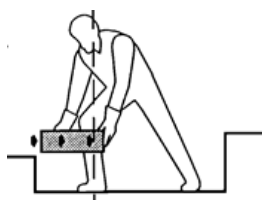

In order to be JHSC certified in Ontario, members must complete certification with a Chief Prevention Officer (CPO) approved training provider.

Safetyscope is an approved provider for JHSC Refresher training.

To be certified, you need to successfully complete:

- JHSC Part 1
- JHSC Part 2 within twelve months of Part 1
- JHSC Refresher Training, which must be

completed every three years in order to remain certified*

You will receive an email reminder when there is six months left to complete refresher training in order to maintain certification status.



This 1-day workshop-style, discussion-based course is designed to:

- Bring JHSC members up-to-date with the latest regulations.
- Provide a review of the key concepts taught in Certification Part One & Part Two training, updates to OHS legislation, as well as best practices.
- The course reminds members of the various duties and responsibilities of the JHSC.
- Sessions are complemented by worksheets, sample paperwork, and reviews hazard identification, meetings, and inspections.

It is relevant to JHSC members in all industry sectors.

After 3 years, the MLITSD will inform certified members that their certification has been revoked if they have not met training and other requirements to maintain their certification.

Other members certified prior to March 2016 should consider taking this course to refresh their knowledge of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and applicable regulations.

*JHSC Refresher Training is required to maintain JHSC certification for anyone who became certified after March 1, 2016.
