Canadian law requires that any person exposed to hazardous materials in the workplace must be trained in Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) to ensure that workers are aware of the hazards of the materials they handle.

It is an employee's responsibility to participate in WHMIS safety training, take necessary measures to protect themselves and co-workers, and to properly identify and control hazardous materials. The onus is on the employer to ensure that hazardous materials are properly labelled, to have SDSs available, and to offer education and training about the products in the workplace.

The goal of WHMIS training is to ensure that workers are:

- Informed
- Aware of the hazards in their workplace
- Know how to protect themselves from exposure to hazards.

- Labelling – Supplier and Workplace Labels
